- 1) Student participants are expected to compete in the competition event with an honest effort to follow the rules and the spirit of the competition.
- 2) The goal of the competition is to give one’s best effort while displaying honesty, integrity, and sportsmanship.
- 3) The robot and the invention design idea for the competition must solely be a product of the students’ own efforts, ideas, and designs with adult mentors/teachers/parents providing verbal advice only. Limited adult help using power tools is allowed.
- 4) Students, coaches, and parents are expected to display courtesy and respect toward THUAASC staffs, volunteers, other teams, and guests of the competition.
- 5) Please remember all judges and officials are volunteer specialists in their field and should be extended every courtesy.
- 6) Failure to show honesty and/or courtesy by a participant, coach, or guest of the team may result in the disqualification of the team from that game and/ or from the entire competition event.
